




Lesson One – The Bible

Article One - The Bible

We believe the Bible is the Inerrant, Infallible, Inspired and Authoritative Word of God. It does not contain the Word of God. It is the Word of God. Therefore, it is sufficient for things pertaining to God, life and living as it relates to its claims, commands, laws, doctrines and instructions. Furthermore, there is no salvation for fallen humanity outside of that which is contained within its pages. 2 Timothy 3:15-17; 2 Peter 1:19-21

Definitions

Inerrant - not capable of being wrong, says what it means to say without omissions or exaggerated information

Infallible - not capable of making mistakes, never failing **Inspired** - of extraordinary quality, as if arising from some external creative impulse; the men who wrote the Bible were Inspired by the Holy Spirit

<u>Authoritative</u> - reliable; trustworthy; commanding and self-confident; likely to be respected and obeyed

The Bible is not the opinions or the memories of the writers, it contains the information and words that the Spirit of God instructed them to write. By inspired men to write the Bible, God has revealed Himself to us.

General Revelation – Psalm 19:12, Acts 14:15-17 Special Revelation – Genesis 6:13-22, Exodus 3:1-3

Trusting the Bible as True

The Bible proves itself. Throughout human history and in Jesus Christ Himself, Biblical Prophecy has come to pass time and time again.

Basic Bible Facts

• •

- It took about 1500 years to "write" the Bible
- The Bible is divided into 2 sections called Testaments
- The Word **Testament** means Covenant/Promise
- There are 66 Books in the Bible
- There are 39 in the Old Testament
- There are 27 in the New Testament
- The First 5 Books of the Old Testament are called the Books of Law, the Pentateuch or the Books of Moses
- The Rest of the Old Testament is split into 3 more sections, Books of History, Poetry, and the Major and Minor Prophets
- <u>The Overall Message of the</u> <u>Old Testament is that the</u> <u>Messiah is Coming!!!</u>
- The First 4 Books of the New Testament are called the **Gospels**
- The Word Gospel means Good News. The Gospels contain the Good News of Jesus Christ
- The Rest of the New Testament is split into 3 more sections, 1 Book of History, 1 Book of Prophecy and Epistles
- The Word **Epistles** means Letters
- <u>The Overall Message of the</u> <u>New Testament is that the</u> <u>Messiah has come and will</u> <u>come again!</u>
